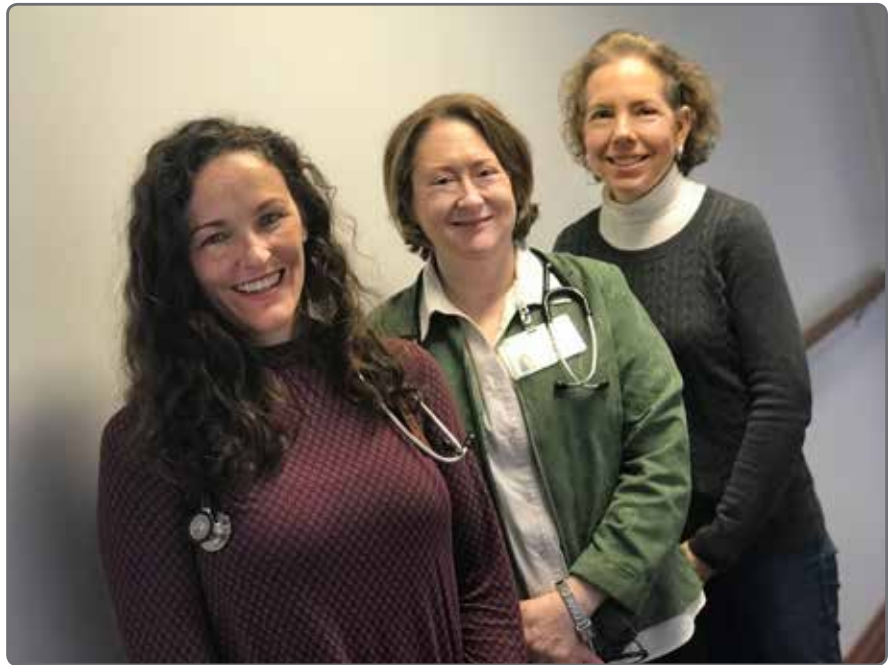


A Message from Our Physicians
